Ann Tutwiler is senior advisor of international programs for the Office of the Chief Scientist at the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Previously, she served as advisor on international trade for the Africa Bureau's sustainable development

group at the U.S. Agency for International Development, and as managing director for trade and development at the William and Flora Hewlett Foundation, concentrating on issues related to international trade, agriculture and other global economic trends. Furthermore, Tutwiler is the former president and CEO of the International Food and Agriculture Trade Policy Council, an organization that she co-founded in 1987 to advocate policies that support an efficient and open global food system. Tutwiler has published dozens of articles and edited two books on international agriculture policies. She has served on the board of the International Fertilizer Development Council, the Partnership to Cut Hunger and Poverty in Africa, and the Dean Rusk International Studies Program at Davidson College.



Dr. Terry L. Roberts was named president of the International Plant Nutrition Institute (IPNI) as it began operations in January 2007. IPNI is a not-for-profit, scientific organization dedicated to the responsible management of plant nutri-

ents. Terry had previously served as president of the Potash and Phosphate Institute.

A native of Alberta, Canada, Terry grew up in a family-owned and operated retail fertilizer business. He received a B.S.A. in Crop Science from the University of Saskatchewan and a Ph.D. in Soil Fertility and Plant Nutrition from the same institution. In 2001, he was recognized as a Fellow of the American Society of Agronomy (ASA).


