ASVA Organization:	The ASVA is a web-based model in which pertinent factors are considered, ranked and weighted against one another for the issues specific to a retail facility. The ASVA tool allows the retailer to answer questions online concerning the facility's current status and receive a computer-generated rating for Risk and Vulnerability. Participants receive a final report complete with recommended countermeasures. Key and central to the ASVA methodology is the utilization of layers of protection. The layers help demonstrate to facility management and personnel potential ways to improve site security in an incremental fashion, thus allowing for more informed decisions and effective implementation.
