## **Flexibility**

- The 'Heavy Metals Rule' SUIP 25
  - Original Policy Final in 2003
  - New information came out of Metals forum (Rufus Chaney, USDA) – foraging animal pathway
  - Outcome changed Cobalt recommendation & TFI commissioned fresh Risk Assessment & revised (lower) values adopted (Tentative)

#### A New Part of the Model Bill

- Compost Uniform Bill culmination of a 10 year effort
  - Definitions went to L&D committee
  - Environmental Committee dealt with claims of benefits & came to mutually acceptable conclusions
  - Lab Committee checked out methods
  - Uniform Bills produced final compost bill. (actually needed because of industries with to claim nutrients requiring dual registration (soil amendment) in some states.

#### A New Class of Materials

- Silicon triggered a whole new way to look at things as it is technically not an essential nutrient, but growth is poor without it – hence developed a new definitions 'Beneficial Substance'.
  - Silicon compounds accepted, pending analytical methods.
  - Nickel actually a remedy for past agronomic input – Zinc & other metals

## **Analytical Methods**

- Analytical & Sampling Methods are a cornerstone of any regulatory system
- Recent constant restructuring of AOAC
  - Previously the foundation of our methods, but not the only source (AFPC, etc), there has been a drift of AOAC International away from its roots (originally Association Of Agricultural Chemists) as fiscal needs the became preeminent.
  - Attempts to keep ag interests with peer groups of experts & list of priorities, but methods developed by all volunteer groups no longer making it through the system.
  - The metals method of Kane & Hall one of the last.
  - We are now looking at generating our own methods using the same protocols – essentially doing what we have been providing as volunteers to AOAC for years. Sulphur methods.

#### Methods contd.

- Methods in Process
  - Silicon Products pursued by industry
  - Sulphur methods recent need for 'organic' sulphur – not analyzed by current methods
  - Slow Release close to a collaborative study
- International Uniformity

## **Preemption**

- Preemption of Local Fertilizer Regulation opposition to this is now permanent AAPFCO policy
  - e.g. in Florida Often driven by niche marketing & PR. Moved to the statewide arena. Then ends up back in AAPFCO court urban turf definitions adopted tentative
